Core Trainings: Core Trainings are required for volunteers in all programs, ywca Board and Staff. New CASA volunteers must attend Domestic Violence 101 on January 12th and Be An Effective Ally on January 24th. The Introduction to Volunteer Service and Sexual Assault 101 Core Trainings need to be completed within the first 6 months of service as a CASA Volunteer.
